Shall St. Croix County be allowed to exceed this limit and increase the levy for the next fiscal year, 2024, for the purpose of Public Safety, by a total of 7.98%, which results in a levy of \$47,855,666, and on an ongoing basis, include the increase of \$3,536,507 each fiscal year going forward?</p> |
